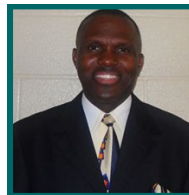

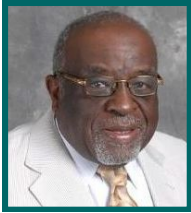

**Bishop Otto Richardson, Jr., Pastor  
True Gospel Apostolic Faith Church, Inc.**



Bishop Otto Richardson, Jr., a native of Burnt Corn, Alabama was born into a family of 14 children. He is the third child of the late Otto, Sr. and Emma Richardson. When the Richardson family migrated to Baltimore, Maryland in 1963, he met Dorothy Ritchey. On March 5, 1966, he and Lady Dorothy Richardson were married.

They are blessed with two children: Darryl and Monique. Feeling the drawing of the Lord Jesus Christ, Bishop Rich-

ardson walked away from membership in one of Baltimore, Maryland's most prestigious Baptist Churches. He was unsure of where the Lord was sending him. Obeying the leading of the Lord, Bishop Richardson was baptized in Jesus Name in October 1974 and received the infilling of the Holy Ghost. He began to evangelize throughout Baltimore and to visit John Hopkins Hospital to pray for the sick. On one such visit he met, Elder Neal Reaves. Elder Reaves introduced him to Bishop Alfred Wallace, Pastor of the Apostolic Church of Jesus, located at 1347 Myrtle Avenue, Baltimore, MD.

He continued to evangelize under the leadership of Bishop Wallace and was later elevated to Assistant Pastor. After serving in this ministry for 13 years, God again elevated Bishop Richardson to a Pastoral ministry. In January 1987, True Gospel Apostolic Faith Church humbly began at 1412 Gorsuch Avenue, in the basement of his sister's home (Evangelist Hattie Richardson). A man of vision, he sought to find another location for worship services.

On February 1, 1987, Pastor Richardson and his small band of saints began worship services at 631 N. Pulaski Street. As membership grew, Pastor Richardson sought to purchase their first edifice located at 1508 N. Fulton Avenue, Baltimore, MD.

In 1991 Pastor Richardson sought the Lord for organizational membership, which led him to the Pentecostal Churches of the Apostolic Faith (PCAF). The Lord continued to bless Pastor Richardson and the congregation on Fulton Avenue.

At the recommendation of Bishop John T. Leslie, Jr., on August 3, 1994, Pastor Richardson was elevated to District Elder status at the National Convention of the PCAF.

On July 11, 1995, True Gospel migrated to Northeast-Baltimore to its present address, 2715 Grindon Avenue, Baltimore, MD. In July 2004, he was elevated to Jurisdictional Bishop at the National Convention of the PCAF.

On Tuesday, August 7, 2012 Jurisdictional Bishop Richardson was ordained an Episcopal Bishop at the National Convocation of the PCAF. In addition to this elevation, Bishop Richardson is honored to be appointed Council Bishop of the newly formed North Carolina District Council of the Pentecostal Churches of the Apostolic Faith Association, Int'l.

By the grace of God, Bishop Richardson continues to dedicate his life to the work of the Lord.

## Biographical Sketch

*Elder Jeffrey Mann, Pastor*

*Freedom Temple of Praise—Rocky Mount, NC*



*Elder Jeffrey Mann was first called into ministry in March of 1997 as an exhorter in Bible Way Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ World Wide Inc. Elder Mann was a faithful member of Faith Apostolic Temple under the leadership of Pastor Elester K. Thigpen. Under the authority of his Pastor, Elder Mann made full proof of his ministry by doing the work of an evangelist. Elder Mann gave himself completely into soul winning and as a result of his*

*love for souls; many souls were delivered, filled with the Holy Ghost and disciplined for the furtherance of ministry. At Faith Apostolic Temple, Elder Mann headed the evangelistic team and was president of the men's ministry.*

*Later on Elder Mann was lead to Warrenton, NC to the Refuge Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, under the leadership of Pastor Robert Terry, where he was consecrated as a minister. Elder Mann and his family traveled faithfully over 500 miles weekly to support the work of the Lord and because of his faithfulness as well as the anointing upon his life; he was made vice-president of the youth ministry.*

*In 1999, God called Elder Mann into the Pastoral ministry. He accepted the calling in 2001. In January 2001, Freedom Temple of Praise was birthed. In July of 2001, Elder Mann was ordained as Elder and Pastor in Akron, Ohio in The Bible Way Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ World Wide Inc., under the leadership of Bishop Cornelius Showell who is the Sr. Pastor of First Apostolic Church in Baltimore, Maryland and serves as the Apostle of Bible Way Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Inc. In June of 2007, Elder Mann was lead by the Lord to come into covenant with Fresh Harvest Ministries, under the authority of the Apostolic Prelate Bishop Courtney A. Pope.*

*Pastor Jeffrey Mann currently functions in the position of Episcopal Assistant of Fresh Harvest Ministries Church and Ministry Fellowship. This Ministry could not be possible first and foremost without the loving support of his wife, First Lady Debra Mann, his daughters, Dyesha and Destiny, his son, Elijah, and the Freedom Temple of Praise covenant members, who Elder Mann calls the best saints that a Pastor could pray for.*
