**Dr. Eula Payne-Williams, Overseer
El Bethel Cathedral Ministries**



Dr. Eula Payne—Williams was born in Montgomery, Alabama February 6 to Wilbert and Lula Delores Payne. While she was in Elementary School she moved to Richford, New York and then while in High School to Ithaca, New York.

Dr. Payne was baptized in Jesus' Name and filled with the Holy Ghost in July 1963 at the Bethlehem Church of Jesus Christ, pastor, the late Bishop Cecil A. Malone.

Dr. Payne received her Associate of Arts degree from Tompkins Cortland Community College. In 1986, she entered Cornell University to pursue a degree in law. It was then that Dr. Payne was commissioned of the Lord to evangelize full-time.

Dr. Payne was ordained an Evangelist by the Pentecostal Churches of the Apostolic Faith (PC of AF) in August 1987. She served as Pastoral Assistant to her pastor, Bishop James Nelson of the Greater Bethlehem Temple Church, Baltimore, MD. On November 24, 1990, Dr. Payne received her Doctoral Degree of Theology (Th.D) from the Pentecostal Bible College. In June 1994, Dr. Payne received her DD and PhD from the International Bible College of Grace and Truth, Dayton, OH.

On March 12, 1995, Dr. Payne was appointed the pastor of the Greater Morning Star Apostolic Church in South Boston, Virginia. On September 11, 1995 she became the Dean of the Virginia Institute of Bible Studies in South Boston, VA.

In August 2004, Dr. Williams became the pastor and founder of El Bethel Cathedral Ministries located at 1511 Noblin Avenue, South Boston, VA.

In October 2005, Dr. Williams relinquished the position of pastor of El Bethel Cathedral Ministries to her husband; Bishop John Williams and she now hold the position as overseer of El Bethel Cathedral Ministries.

Created, Called and Commissioned to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ, Dr. Eula Williams has preached both national and internationally as a bold warrior for Christ. Being a woman of prayer and dedication, God has given her the ministry of deliverance and reconciliation, making her a blessing to the lost and hurting.

Dr. Williams is an ordained minister in the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. (PAW).

Dr. Williams is well respected and held in high esteem among her peers and family. She is never too busy. She is never too tired. Her heart is always on the work and the people of the Lord.

Biographical Sketch

*Bishop Luther Moore, Pastor
Emmanuel Temple Church, Wilmington, NC*



Bishop Moore was born and raised in Philadelphia, PA. He was baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ and filled with the gift of the Holy Ghost in July 1976 under the late Bishop Albert Ford, Sr.

Bishop Moore acknowledged the call to Ministry in 1977 and began street Ministry under the guidance and direction of Bishop Ford which would continue for the next nine years.

Literally hundreds of souls were baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ, throughout his tenure as outreach coordinator for Emmanuel Temple under the late Bishop Ford.

Bishop Moore was called to the Pastorate in January of 1986 in the City of Philadelphia where he served as Pastor of the Newly Founded Emmanuel Temple Church, Inc., at which time he moved organizational Fellowship from the P.A.W to the PCAF where he remained for 15 years. After serving eight years as Pastor in Philadelphia the Lord led Bishop Moore to North Carolina in 1993 to establish a new work. Emmanuel Temple Church, Inc., Family Outreach and Worship Center was established.

Bishop Moore attended Westview Bible College and New Life Christian Bible College and received degrees in Christian Education and Biblical Studies.

Bishop Moore currently serves as the North Carolina Regional Bishop for Greater Emmanuel International Fellowship, the honorable Bishop Edward E Shouse; Pastor at Temple of Praise in Columbus, Ohio is Presiding Prelate.

There are two particular versus of scriptures that have driven Bishop Moore throughout the years:

Romans 8:38-39 - For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
